Job Title: Er-Hu teacher

Job Description: Er-Hu is a Chinese traditional instrument, popular in China, and gaining popularity in certain circles in the United States. We are seeking a qualified music teacher to teach private Er-Hu lessons to our students, and to grow a private Er-Hu instruction studio within Bender Conservatory.

About Us: We provide professional, one-on-one, in-person, private music instruction. We have developed a unique training system that focuses on rudimentary technique and mastery, rather than learning songs and playing by ear. Our students usually become accomplished musicians with four years of training at our conservatory.

About the Role: You will help distinguish our conservatory with professionalism, by applying our Bender proprietary teaching technique and training practices. You will build your student-base and build client loyalty to the Bender name. Among the responsibilities of the role are:

Education: You will teach private er-hu instruction in a one-to-one setting, with a high degree of professionalism, according to our specific Bender teaching pedagogy, our specific Bender curriculum, which involved employing continued use of the metronome to teach music.

Opportunity Development: You will manage the client relationship based upon student learning retention, including documenting lesson notes, giving lesson grades, and assisting in producing the final session Bender studio recital.
